## **General Information for Overseas Participants**

1. Training Venue: The Hong Kong Girl Guides Association  
Jockey Club Beas River Lodge  
Kwu Tung, Sheung Shui, New Territories,  
HONG KONG
2. Registration Fee: The fee is USD375 which will cover local transportation between airport and training venue, transportation for outdoor activities, food, accommodation (double room), course materials, course T-shirt and educational tour.
3. Airport Reception: Scout Leaders in uniform will meet you at the Hong Kong International Airport. Local transportation by coach/vehicle/public transportation will be arranged. Please ensure that you send your travel itinerary in advance (by 9 September, 2023) to our secretariat via email: 5thCLT@scouting.org.hk
4. Arrival/Departures: Arrive Hong Kong on 29 September, 2023 (Friday) afternoon / evening  
Depart Hong Kong on 4 October, 2023 (Wednesday) after the closing ceremony which ends at 16:00 (the course may try to accommodate for those participants who need an earlier departure)
5. Accommodation: Jockey Club Beas River Lodge  
Kwu Tung, Sheung Shui, New Territories,  
HONG KONG (<https://www.hkggacnpeng.org/jcbrl>)  
Double Room accommodation (two participants per room) for 5 nights (check-in on 29 September and check-out on 4 October) will be arranged. Additional fee of USD125 will be incurred for Single Room accommodation. Please indicate your preference in advance.
6. Catering: A variety of cuisine will be arranged during the course. Those with food allergy or dietary requirement are advised to inform us in advance.
7. Visa: Please inquire locally if you require entry visa to Hong Kong. If yes, please inform us with your passport details well in advance to allow us to prepare an invitation letter or other documents as may be required by you for visa application.
8. Insurance: Participants shall arrange their own travel and medical insurance.

9. Climate: The weather in September / October is warm and humid but is gradually getting cooler when entering the autumn season. There is a chance of tropical cyclones with strong winds and heavy rainfall. Temperature will be between 26°C to 30°C.
10. What to Bring: Scout uniform, personal clothing, national costume, laptop computer / tablet, smartphone, personal medical kit, toiletries, etc.  
NSO information regarding Youth Programme, Adult Resources, organization structure, etc.  
NSO flag (~ 4 feet × 3 feet)
11. Attire: Full Scout Uniform for official ceremonies and welcome dinner.  
National Costume for Cultural Evening.  
Course T-Shirt for lectures and Educational Tour.  
NSO Scarf / Gilwell Scarf to be worn.  
It is advised not to wear sandals during course activities.
12. Currency: The official currency is Hong Kong Dollars. Electronic payment through credit card or Octopus card (stored value card) is the most common form of payment.
13. Electricity: Standard voltage is 220VAC at 50 Hz. Power plug is Type G (United Kingdom plug)
