1. Participant are Rover or Senior Rover ages 16 to 25 years and can present the WOSM Safe From Harm E-Learning Certificate.
2. Contingent Leader is at least 23 years old, preferably the Member of National Rover Council or equivalent role, and can present the WOSM Safe From Harm E-Learning Certificate.
3. Participants must obtain an endorsement letter from NSO.
4. Have been fully vaccinated and received booster (Covid-19).
5. Must be in good physical and mental health.
6. Have personal health insurance that is still valid and can be used internationally.
